Christmas Cheer is a beautifully conformed young female with excellent head and points coverage.

We have not shown her because she has a mid fawn spot on her right flank. She is currently mated to Lee Carrow Jim-Bob and due to birth in February 2010.

(We bought Chiripa at the National Auction in 2003. She is a daughter of Ruffo, and has given us good quality cria every time. At purchase Chiripa's fleece statistics were Micron 21.4, SD 3.5, CV 16.6%, CF 98.3%. Her April 2008 fleece test was Micron 22.2, SD 3.9, CV 17.9%, CF 97.5%. Cameo and Christmas Cheer are two beautiful daughters of Chiripa. Their sire Traron Everest has contributed density and fibre definition to compliment Chiripa's excellent fleece qualities).

Kismet has given us consistently good cria and is currently mated to Lee Carrow Jim-Bob whose profile is presented on our website.

Mated to Lee Carrow The Breaker SW on 30/7/2009. (Lee Carrow The Breaker won = Victorian Central Region Fleece of the Year 2006. He has the same dam as Lee Carrow Seventh Heaven (sold for \$56,000 at the National Auction 2008). PF Sweet Dreams' dam is a fawn huacaya from the mating of two suris. We were looking to play with the colour genetics of this girl over time. First fleece: 18.9, SD 4.1, CV 21.6%, CF 99.3%. Sweet Dreams is a beautifully conformed young female who demonstrates great presence in the paddock.
